This responds to your petition for rulemaking (P-1630) requesting amendments to the Hazardous Materials Regulations (HMR; 49 CFR Parts 171-180) relating to cylinders. Specifically, you ask the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) to revise the regulations for Department of Transportation (DOT)-4L welded insulated cylinders to clarify what constitutes a "repair" versus a "rebuild."

PHMSA has assessed your petition and determined that your petition to clarify a "repair" versus a "rebuild" merits consideration in a future rulemaking in accordance with § 106.105. All correspondence relative to this petition will be transferred to the petition (P-1630) docket (PHMSA-2014-0027) and you may comment on the petition in accordance with the procedures in Part 106, Subpart B.
